Opposition to SB 228: AN ACT ALLOWING A PUBLIC EMPLOYEE TO WITHDRAW FROM A BARGAINING UNIT; PROVIDING FOR WRITTEN NOTICE; ESTABLISHING THE TIMELINE FOR PAYMENT OF DUES TO CEASE;
