Vice Chair – Representative A. Regier- Mr. Chair, I move HB#565 do pass. (Standard opening motion)

Representative Lenz-"Very much a boutique bill for a specific and special group. Noted the extra special group that represents the nurses. The organization that promoted it represents 20% of nurses. Brought up as part of it that Sports Officials were called out separately, and I am grateful that sports officials are brought in the law.... so I can mention that this is silly too...." **Representative A. Regier**: "I feel like as the nurse in the room, I feel like I should chime in here. I would echo everything that Representative Lenz said. Many others help the nurses in these scenarios, the ER. To say that one is more valuable than the other but this law, I just don't agree with that, and there are many laws on the books already."

Representative Berglee- made a substitute motion to table. (This kills a bill if passes) **Representative Kelker**- calls for a roll call vote.
