

 Provisional approval for up to 1 year – need for close monitoring of the organization



Organizational Overview (OO)

OO1: Demographics-1000 word limit

OO2: Lines of Authority and Administrative Support (Structural Capacity)

- List-Primary Nurse Planner (PNP)/Nurse Planners (NPs)
- Position descriptions related to Approved Provider Unit role
 - See FAQs for example position descriptions for PNP/NP
 - Current, unrestricted nursing license, BSN or higher in nursing
 - PNP
 - NP

SC 1: PNP Commitment

 SC 1: The PNP's commitment to learner needs, including how approved provider unit processes are revised based on aggregate data, which may include but is not limited to individual educational activity evaluation results, stakeholder feedback, and learner/customer feedback.

SC 2: PNP Accountability

 How the PNP ensures that all NPs in the provider unit are appropriately oriented and trained to implement and adhere to the ANCC Accreditation Criteria.

SC 3: PNP/NP Leadership

 How the PNP and/or NP provides direction and guidance to individuals involved in planning, implementing, and evaluating continuing nursing education (CNE) activities in compliance with Accreditation criteria.

Education Design Process

ASSESSMENT

- EDP 1: The process used to identify a problem in practice or an opportunity for improvement (professional practice gap).

 See FAQs for Difference
- EDP 2: How the NP identifies the underlying educational needs (knowledge, skills, and/or practices) that contribute to the professional practice gap.
- EDP 3: How the NP measures change in knowledge, skills, and/or practices of the target audience that are expected to occur as a result of participating in the educational activity.
 - See FAQs for sample process description of how the NP identifies and measures a change in knowledge, skills and/or practices that are expected to occur (EDP3)

Education Design Process, cont

PLANNING

• EDP 4: The process used to identify, mitigate, and disclose relevant financial relationships for all individuals in a position to control educational content.

Education Design Process, cont

DESIGN PRINICIPLES

- EDP 5: How content of educational activities is developed based on best available current evidence to foster achievement of desired outcomes (e.g. clinical guidelines, peer-reviewed journals, experts in the field).
- EDP 6: How strategies to promote learning and actively engage learners are incorporated into educational activities.
- EDP 7: How the summative evaluation data for an educational activity are used to analyze the outcome(s) of that activity and guide future activities.

Quality Outcomes

QO 1: EVALUATION PROCESS: The process used for evaluating the overall effectiveness of the approved provider unit in carrying out its work as a provider of continuing nursing education.

QO 2: APU Evaluation Process

QO2a: Identify at least one quality outcome the provider unit has established and worked to achieve over the past twelve months to improve provider unit operations. Identify the metrics used to measure success in achieving that outcome.

QO2b: Using one of the quality outcomes identified in QO2a, explain how the most recent evaluation process (QO1) resulted in the development and/or improvement of an identified outcome for provider unit operations, including how that outcome was measured and analyzed.

QO3: Value/Benefit to Nursing Professional Development

QO 3a: Identify at least one quality outcome the provider unit has established and worked to achieve over the past twelve months to improve the professional development of nurses. Identify the metrics used to measure success in achieving that outcome.

QO 3b: Using one of the **outcomes** identified in QO3a, explain how the most recent evaluation process (QO1) resulted in the **development and/or improvement** of an identified outcome to **improve the professional development of nurses**, including how that outcome was **measured and analyzed**.
